## Addendum To Preston Hollow Homeowners' Association Architectural Control Design Guidelines Revised October 2012

## Revised June 11th, 2025

Paragraph VII, A., 7, Page 9 of 19 To Read as Follows:

Dog Runs: A Dog Run is defined as; "an enclosed area of space where a dog can stay without a leash". It is usually gated and locked so that other animals cannot enter and so that a dog cannot escape. Preferably, a dog run shall be located in the rear of the residence. However, a dog run may be permitted to a side yard if shielded from street view or other natural vegetation. Dog runs in front yard are prohibited. Only one (1) dog run per lot is allowed. Dog runs may only be situated on one side or rear of the dwelling not to exceed 12 feet by 40 feet and/or 480 square feet and not extend past the front corner of the dwelling. Dog runs must meet all applicable setback requirements. All fencing material must not be more the 6 feet in height measured from the ground on which it stands. All fencing material and placement must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee.
